



Summer at St. David's 2022 Policies

1. In the event your child becomes ill and/or has a temperature reading of 100 or higher, the school will call you to come pick up your child immediately. In the event you cannot be reached on first attempt the school will start calling the emergency contacts listed until someone is reached to come pick up your child. We cannot stress enough the importance of timely pick up.
2. In the event your child becomes ill with COVID-19, you must alert the school immediately and remain out of *Summer at St. David's* for 5 days. Day 0 is the first day of symptoms or the day that the child tests positive, if asymptomatic. Day 1 is the first day after symptoms develop or the first full day after positive test. Your child may return to school on Day 6 with a negative PCR or Rapid Results test administered by a medical professional (taken on Day 5). If you prefer not to test your child, they may return to school on Day 11 if they have been symptom-free for 24 hours (fever-free without fever-reducing medication).
3. Once registration is complete, no refunds will be issued except for the following conditions: (1) *Summer at St. David's* is unable to open and start as planned or (2) your child tests positive with COVID-19. Refunds will be given on a "per day basis" meaning, if your child attends *Summer at St. David's* on Monday and Tuesday but develops symptoms/tests positive for COVID-19 on Wednesday you will be reimbursed for only Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.
4. All students must be completely up to date on vaccinations. Updated immunization record must be provided with the *Summer at St. David's* application if the school does not already have it on file for your child.
